11mm, the International Football Film Festival, celebrates an exciting finale with ecstatic winners and a record audience

Berlin (March 18 2010) – As has become tradition, the International Football Film Festival 11mm concluded with the 11mm shortkicks gala on Wednesday evening. The short film competition was won by the German film "Des Königs Fußball jüngster Trabant" by Walter G. Puls following a close vote by the star studded jury from football and film, including Rufus Beck, Thomas Thieme, Marlene Assmann, Jimmy Hartwig, Pablo Thiam and Claudio Luciani. For the first time in the seven year history of 11mm, two films tied in the vote for the best football film of 2010 cast by the festival audience: "Eisern Verein" by Andreas Gräfenstein and "Hoffenheim – Das Leben ist kein Heimspiel" by Rouven Rech and Frank Pfeiffer. The directors of both films were on hand in Berlin to collect The Golden Eleven award and celebrate their achievement. Presented by the German Football Federation's Cultural Foundation and the club "Brot und Spiele", 11mm 2010 marked a further increase in the number and quality of films from around the world. 39 documentary and feature films competed for the Golden Eleven and the 3,200 guests over the five day festival set a new record for this unique cinematic football event.
